

## Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide

### Situation up to 18<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at 18:00 AM

#### Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The epidemic is still spreading all over the world.
- An increasing number of countries (both in Northern and Southern hemispheres) present evidence of community transmission (21 countries).

#### France

- To date, 150 confirmed cases were reported, including 1 in French Polynesia and 2 in 2 French departments of America.
- 115 were imported: 13 from Mexico, 75 from USA, 10 from Canada, 5 from Argentina, 8 from Dominican Republic, 1 from Chile and 3 from United-Kingdom.
- 19 are secondary cases linked to an imported case.
- 1 school cluster in the South of France (16 confirmed cases) is under investigation (no history of recent travel).
- 104 suspected cases are under investigation
- 1 severe case has been reported. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>

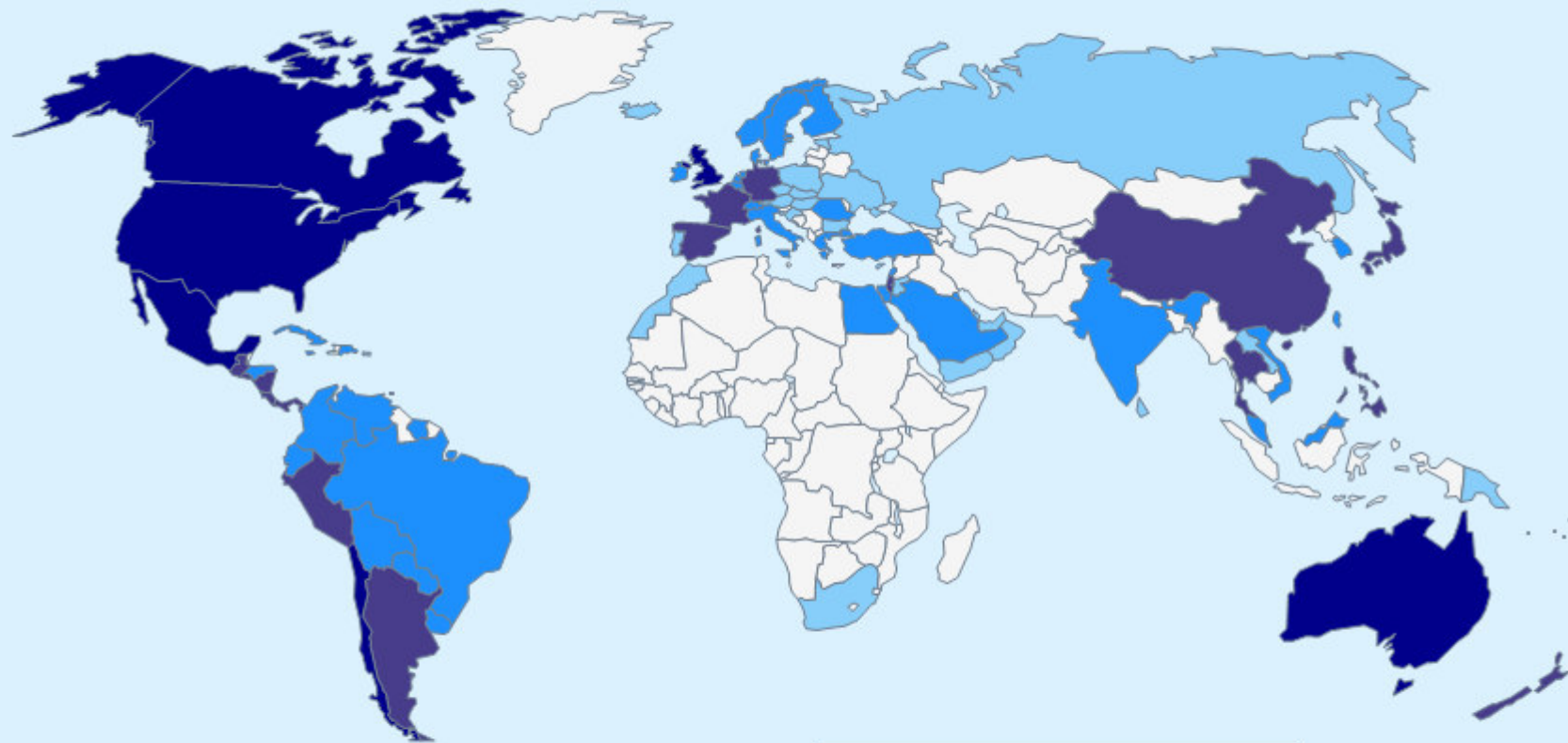
