

**Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide**  
 Situation up to 22<sup>nd</sup> of June 2009 at 11:00 AM

**Worldwide epidemiological situation**

- The epidemic is still spreading in all continents (more than 50 000 cases in total)
- New countries have reported their first cases: **Antigua, Brunei, Bangladesh, Ethiopia and Fiji.**
- Among EpiSouth countries: **Algeria and Slovenia.**

**France**

- To date, **174 confirmed cases** were reported, including 1 in French Polynesia, 1 in Martinique and 1 in Saint-Martin (French departments of America).
- 137 were imported: 85 from USA, 13 from Mexico 12 from Canada, 9 from United-Kingdom, 8 from Dominican Republic, 5 from Argentina, 1 from Chile, 1 from Australia, 1 from Sint Marteen and 1 from Philippines.
- 21 are secondary cases linked to imported cases.
- 82 suspected cases are under investigation
- A cluster of 16 cases with no travel history is located in Haute –Garonne (South-West of France): still under investigation
- 6 clusters linked to cases with travel history
- 1 cluster in "Ile-de-France" (Isle de France province) linked to a school trip back from UK
- The 1<sup>st</sup> severe case reported previously is in stable condition. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>

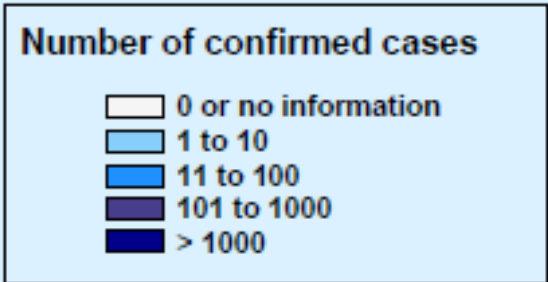
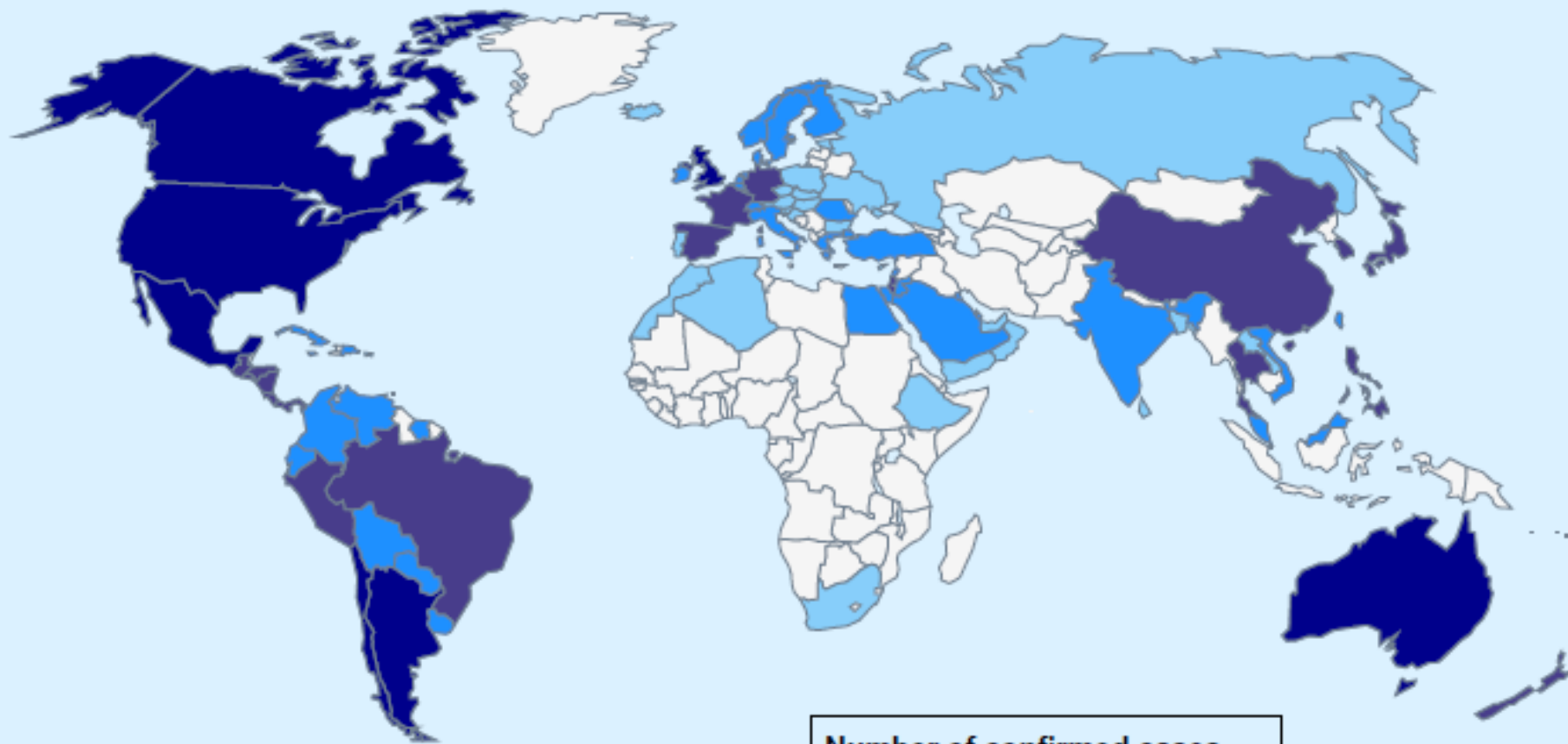
