

## Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide

Situation **up to 06 May 2009 at 11:00 AM**

### Worldwide epidemiological situation

- Cases are being confirmed or excluded continuously. The data available worldwide as of 6<sup>th</sup> of May 2009, at 11:00 AM are presented below.
- Globally, we observe an increase in the confirmed cases reporting. However, this increase in the number of biological confirmed cases is complex to interpret to evaluate the epidemic dynamic.
- 4 new deaths have been confirmed (3 deaths in Mexico and 1 in USA). Secondary cases continue to be notified.
- In North America, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing. There is a high probable active community transmission in specific areas, particularly in USA (New-York, California, Texas, Illinois ...).
- The number of confirmed cases increases in Europe, especially in Spain.

### France

- To date, 5 confirmed cases and 7 probable cases.
- All confirmed cases are imported cases. To date, no severe case has been reported. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>
