

Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide

Situation **up to 07 May 2009 at 11:00 AM**

Worldwide epidemiological situation

- Globally, we observe an increase in the confirmed cases reporting as well as in the number of countries affected. The epidemic is spreading over.
- Secondary cases continue to be notified.
- 13 deaths which occurred in Mexico over the past weeks have been confirmed.
- In North America, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing. There is a high probable active community transmission in specific states in USA as in New-York, California, Texas, Illinois, and Wisconsin; from now, these states have been included in the French case definition. The number of confirmed cases increases in Europe, especially in Spain.

France

- To date, 10 confirmed cases and 5 probable cases.
- All confirmed cases are imported cases. To date, no severe case has been reported. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>

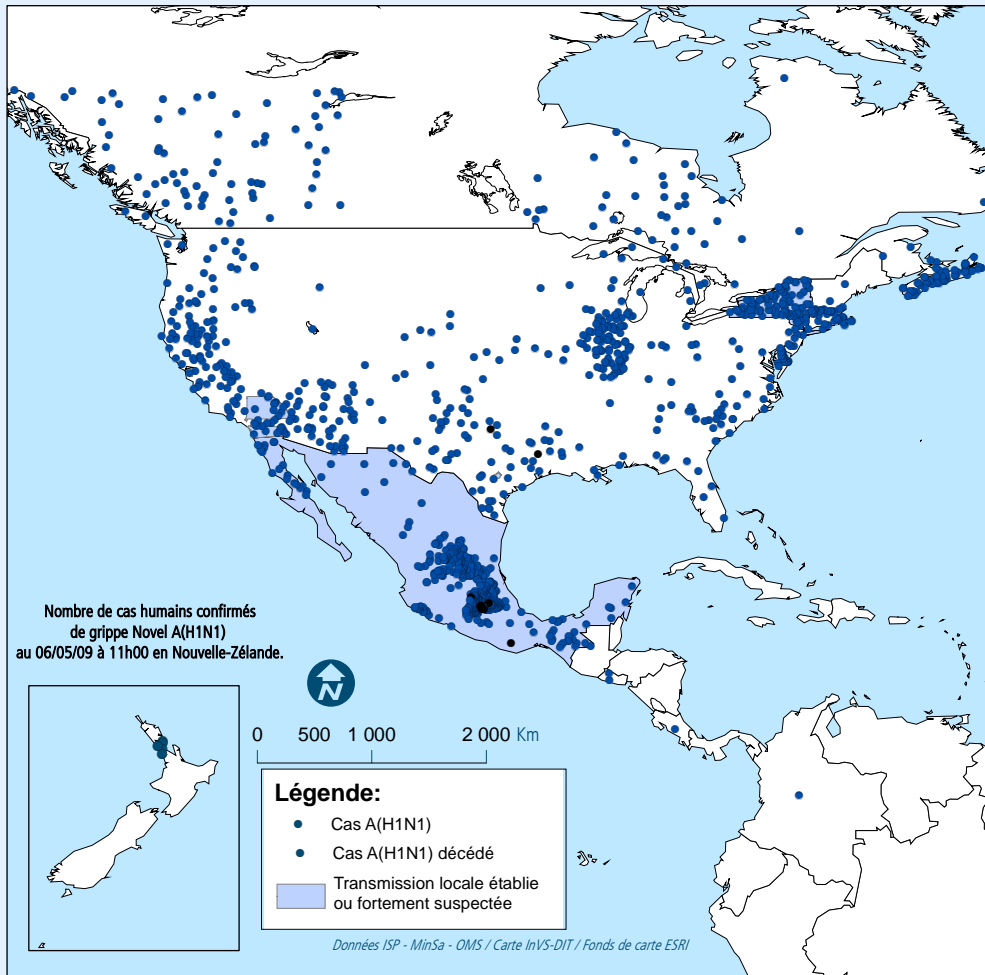

Le Mexique a rapporté 942 cas confirmés, dont 29 décès. Les USA ont rapporté 588 cas confirmés, dont 2 décès.
