

Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide
Situation **up to 05nd of June 2009 at 11:00 AM**

Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The epidemic is still spreading with the evidence of community transmission in several Latin American countries and in Philippines.
- In Europe, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing, especially in Spain.
- To date, we have reached a total number of 21,917 cases and 128 deaths.
- New countries have notified their first cases: **Barbados, Bermuda, Cayman Islands, Nicaragua and Saudi Arabia.**
- Among EpiSouth countries, new countries are: **Egypt.**

France

- To date, 58 confirmed cases were reported, including 1 in French Polynesia.
- 55 were imported: 11 from Mexico, 36 from USA, 2 from Canada and 6 from Dominican Republic.
- 40 suspected cases are under investigation.

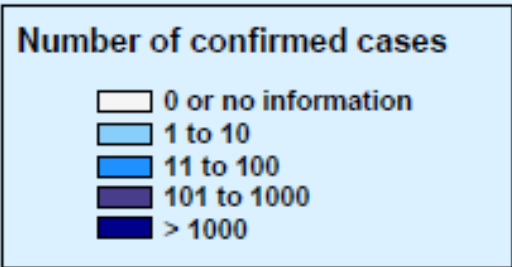
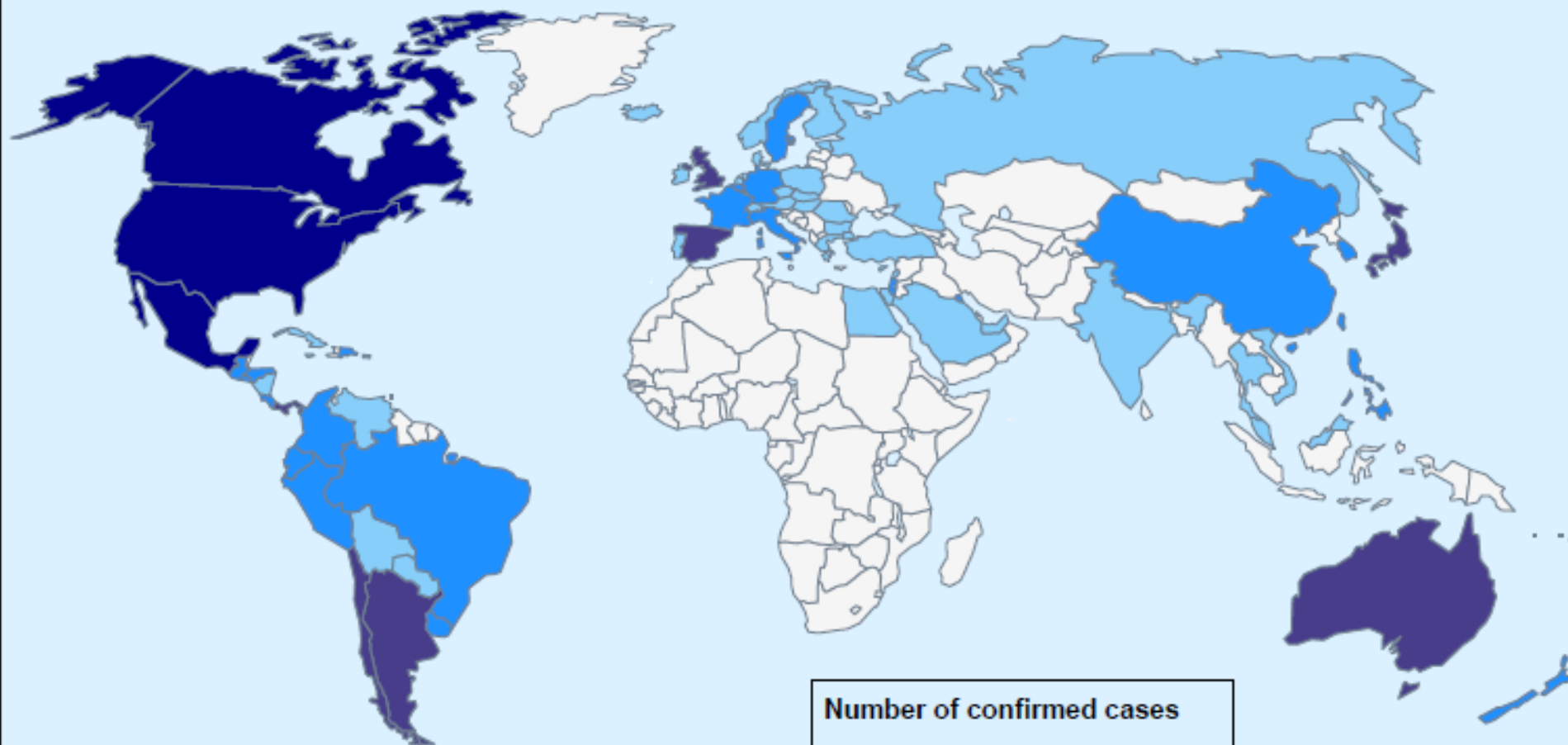
