

## **Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide**

Situation **up to 12 May 2009 at 11:00 AM**

### **Worldwide epidemiological situation**

- The A(H1N1) epidemic is still spreading and the number of confirmed cases continues to increase.
- Secondary cases continue to be notified.
- In Europe: no significant change regarding the global situation.
- The available epidemiological information on North America situation may have an impact on the current case definition and could conduct health authorities to modify it in consequence.

#### **France**

- To date, 13 confirmed cases and 7 probable cases. No severe case has been reported
- All confirmed cases are imported cases, including 2 from New-York and 1 from California. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>
