

Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide Situation up to 13th of July 2009 at 11:00 AM

Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The epidemic is still spreading in all continents: to date, more than 114 725 cases have been reported.
- Since July 06, 2009, new countries have reported their first cases: **Afghanistan, Botswana, Seychelles and Saint Vincent**.
- Among EpiSouth countries: no new county reporting cases.


France

- To date, **464 confirmed cases** were reported, including 399 in France Metropolitan, 6 in Guadeloupe, 3 in Martinique, 5 in French Polynesia, 41 in New Caledonia, and 10 in La Réunion Island:
 - 320 were imported cases or secondary cases linked to imported cases.
 - o 144 cases are not linked to imported cases.
- 23 clusters have been confirmed including 12 with no travel history.
- 37 suspected cases are under investigation.
- As of 13th July, 5 confirmed case required hospitalisation. These cases are between 39 and 70 years old, 3 are female. Among these cases, 3 have been hospitalised for pneumonia, 1 for an acute fever, and 1 for hypoxemia pneumonia. None is a severe case and 3 left already the hospital. No death has been reported.

EpiSouth countries

- On July 13, 2009, **3 420 confirmed A(H1N1) cases** and **2 deaths** have been reported among EpiSouth countries.
- Since July 06, 2009, 843 additional confirmed A(H1N1) cases have been reported.
- Since July 06, 2009, no new country has reported its first case.
