Worldwide epidemiological situation

- Globally, we observe an increase in the reported confirmed cases as well as in the number of affected countries. The epidemic is spreading over.
- Secondary cases continue to be notified.
- In North America, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing. In the USA, there is a high probable active community transmission in some states. This country is moving progressively in the direction of monitoring and reporting as it does for regular seasonal influenza. Consequently, US data should be interpreted carefully.
- In Europe: no major change.

France

- To date, 12 confirmed cases and 3 probable cases.
- All confirmed cases are imported cases. To date, no severe case has been reported. <u>http://www.invs.sante.fr/</u>


