

Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide Situation up to 11 May 2009 at 11:00 AM

Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The A(H1N1) epidemic is still spreading and the number of confirmed cases continues to increase.
- Secondary cases continue to be notified.
- In USA, the active community circulation is now more than probable in several states. In USA, the individual surveillance moves progressively to a routine seasonal influenza surveillance (morbidity, lethality, virology). Data should be interpreted with caution.
- In Europe: no significant change regarding the global situation.

France


- To date, 13 confirmed cases and 5 probable cases.
- All confirmed cases are imported cases. To date, no severe case has been reported. http://www.invs.sante.fr/


