

## Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide

**Situation up to 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at 11:00 AM**

### Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The epidemic is still spreading all over the world.
- In Europe, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing, especially in United-Kingdom, Germany and Spain.

### France

- To date, 106 confirmed cases were reported, including 1 in French Polynesia and 1 in Martinique
- 87 were imported: 11 from Mexico, 60 from USA, 8 from Canada, 1 from Argentina and 7 from Dominican Republic
- 12 cases are secondary ones linked to imported cases
- 1 school cluster (7 confirmed cases) is under investigation (no history of recent travel)
- 59 suspected cases are under investigation

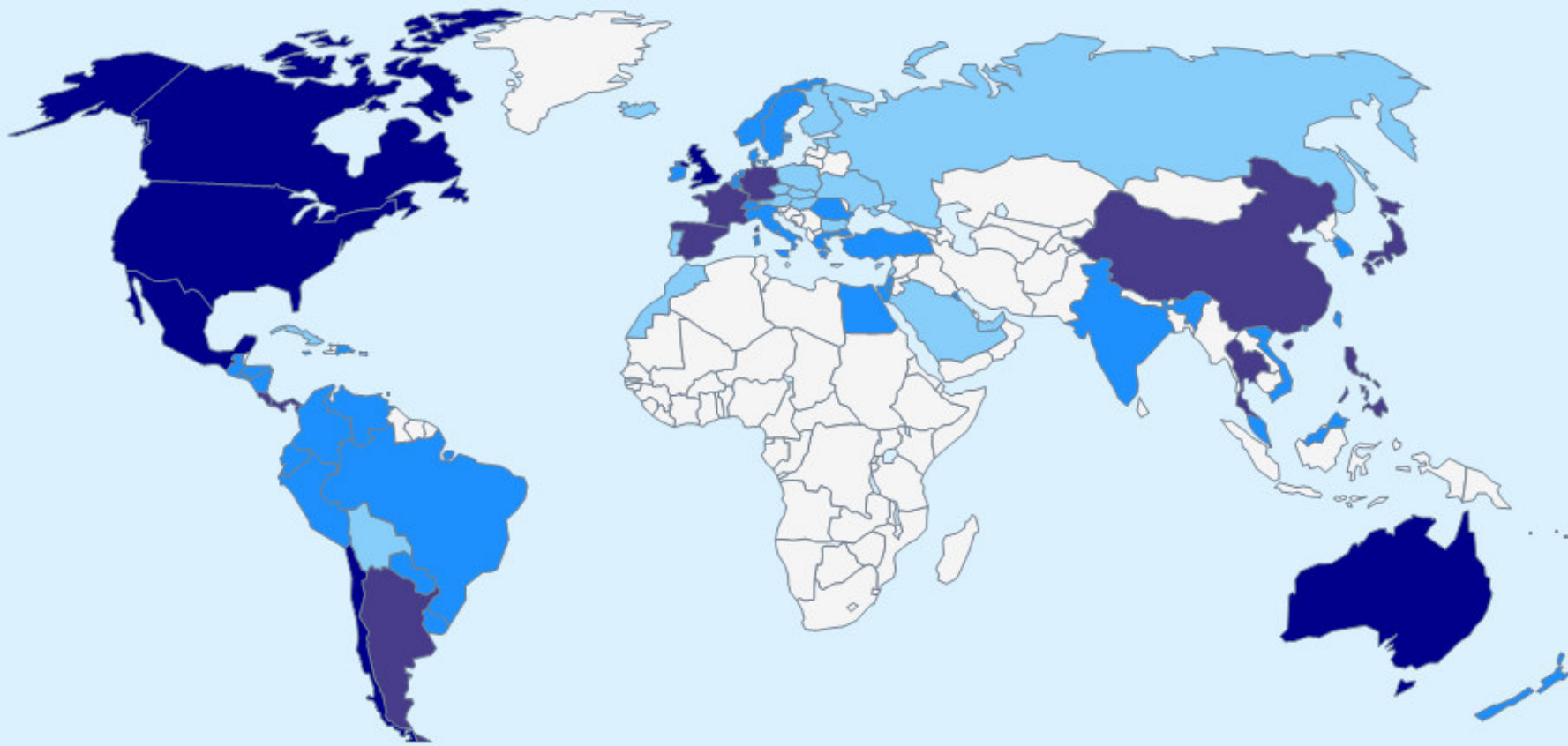
