

## Novel influenza A(H1N1), Worldwide

### Situation up to 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2009 at 11:00 AM

#### Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The epidemic is still spreading all over the world.
- An increasing number of countries (both in Northern and Southern hemispheres) present evidence of community transmission.

#### France

- To date, 133 confirmed cases were reported, including 1 in French Polynesia and 1 in Martinique.
- 101 were imported: 12 from Mexico, 66 from USA, 8 from Canada, 5 from Argentina, 8 from Dominican Republic, 1 from Chile and 1 from United-Kingdom.
- 18 are secondary cases linked to an imported case.
- 1 school cluster in the South of France (14 confirmed cases) is under investigation (no history of recent travel).
- 96 suspected cases are under investigation.

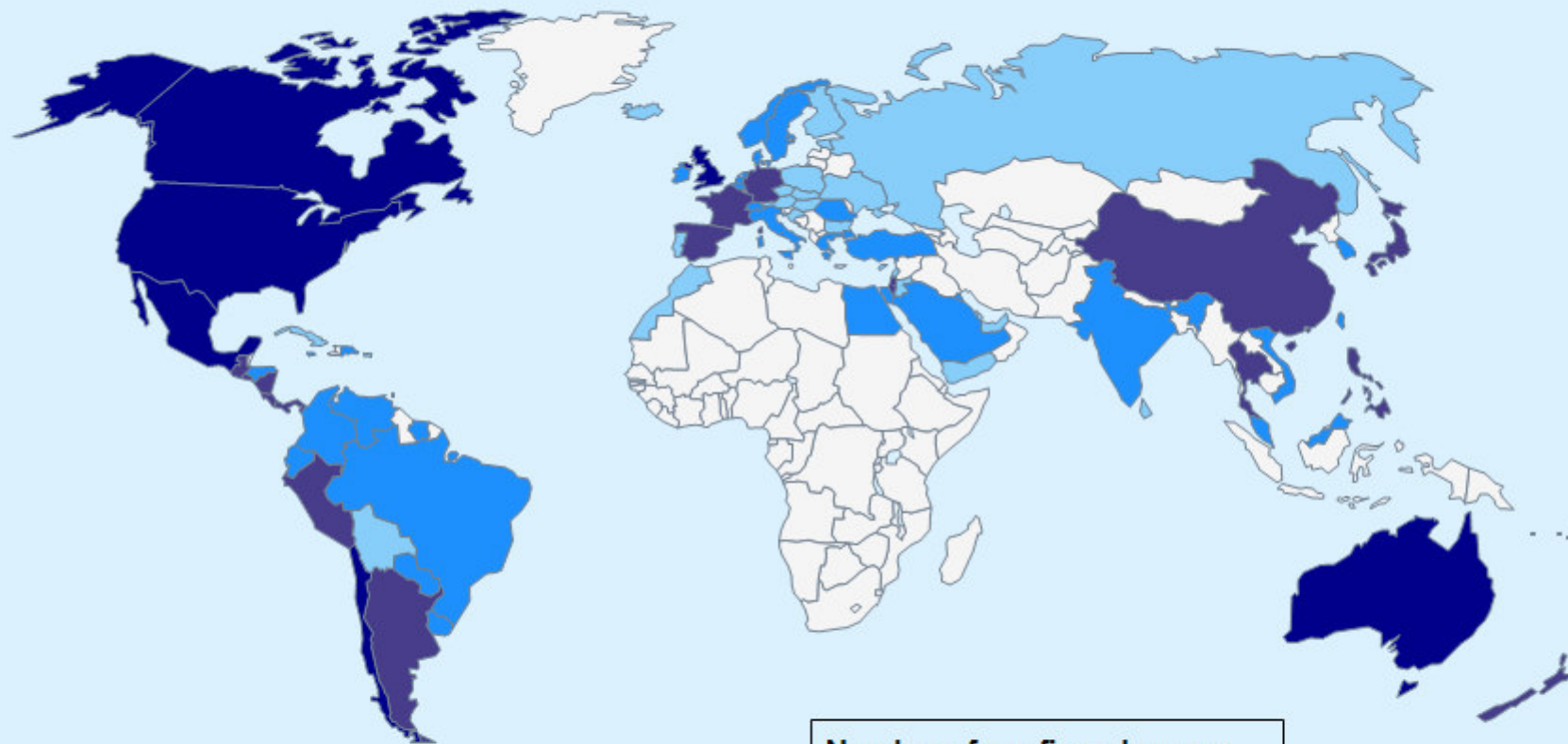
