## Worldwide epidemiological situation

- The A(H1N1) epidemic is still spreading and the number of confirmed cases continues to increase.
- Japan has reported again an increase in the confirmed cases (+80). A community transmission among school environment
  has been notified in 2 provinces.
- In Peru and Chile, imported cases from Dominican Republic have been reported.
- Panama continues to report an important increase of cases.
- In Europe, no significant change regarding the global situation.

#### France

- To date, 16 confirmed cases were notified. All are imported cases: 11 from Mexico and 5 from USA.
- 14 cases are under investigation.
- No severe case has been reported.
- 4 probable cases will never be laboratory confirmed. <u>http://www.invs.sante.fr/</u>


