 Situation up to 29<sup>th</sup> of May 2009 at 11:00 AM

**Worldwide epidemiological situation**

- The epidemic is still spreading, especially in Latin America.
- In Europe, the number of confirmed cases is still increasing, especially in Spain and the UK.
- New countries have notified their first cases: **Bolivia, Slovakia, Paraguay, Dominican Republic, Uruguay and Venezuela.**

**France**

- To date, 26 confirmed cases were reported.
- All were imported: 11 from Mexico, 13 from USA, 1 from Canada and 1 from Dominican Republic.
- 14 suspected cases are under investigation. No severe cases have been reported. <http://www.invs.sante.fr/>
