EpiSouth project meets to review achievements and prospects

Monday, 30 March 2009

The EpiSouth project is holding a meeting on 30 March-1 April to present the status of the project's activities and discuss future prospects, identifying strategic lines of activities and options for financing for the network after the Project's end in September 2009.

About 80 persons are expected to attend the meeting between the countries' Focal Points and guests from the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC), World Health Organization (WHO), European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), World Organization for Animal Health (OIE), Pasteur Institute, and International Organization for Migration (IOM).

The EpiSouth project is co-funded by the EU Public Health Programme (DG SANCO) and the Italian Health Ministry. It started in 2006 from the initiative of some Public Health Institutes that highlighted how Mediterranean countries share common epidemiological characteristics and public health problems. EpiSouth is a now unique project covering all sides of the Mediterranean. The general objective of the project is to create a framework of collaboration on epidemiological issues in order to improve communicable diseases surveillance, communication and training across the area.
