



- Public Health Institute Bucharest was designated as IHR NFP since 2006
- IHR NFP function also as backup for the EWRS along with the Centre for Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases (CPCCD)



- o Advantages existence of:
  - Centre for Prevention and Control of Communicable Diseases
  - Environmental health dept. & national reference laboratory for quality of potable water
  - National laboratory for radiations
  - A trained team which worked non-stop as a coordination center for information during the 2005 severe flooding



- Issues still to be solved
  - Logistics for communication
  - Emergency operation centre
  - Financial mechanism for 24 hour duty (instead of compensatory free days)



- o PH Structure for surveillance and response:
  - Being evaluated since 2001 by WHO and monitored by EC
  - Strengthened in the last years, the process is ongoing
  - Activities are monitored and evaluated through a plan of action, which is currently updated and upgraded
- One of the problems is personnel (less and less people are coming in the Public health domain)



- National reference laboratories in place, well equipped, with trained personnel
- Problems exists still at the regional and especially at the district level related both to personnel and equipment



- Most of them (ports and airports) have already such capacities
- o Challenges:
  - Establishing the list of ground crossings to be designated (EU/non-EU)
  - Increasing number of international airports
  - Complicated mechanism of ownership and management of tasks (at the airports)
- o Required capacities are still to be evaluated

## • • Other activities

- Ongoing process of evaluation of the health facilities designated for international vaccinations and chemoprophylaxis
- Introduction of the new medical documents
  - For travelers
  - For ships

- 5 Regional training workshops for all epidemiologists (134) were held during October
  - December 2006:
    - H5N1 avian influenza

    - Obligations to EWRS
    - March 2008– 2 days workshop with epidemiologists from the districts with points of entry

## • • Training

- o Planned for 2008:
  - Multisectorial training activities, including exercises through the Schengen Center
  - ECDC planned short IHR trainings
  - Laboratory training for regional / district level at Cantacuzino Institute
