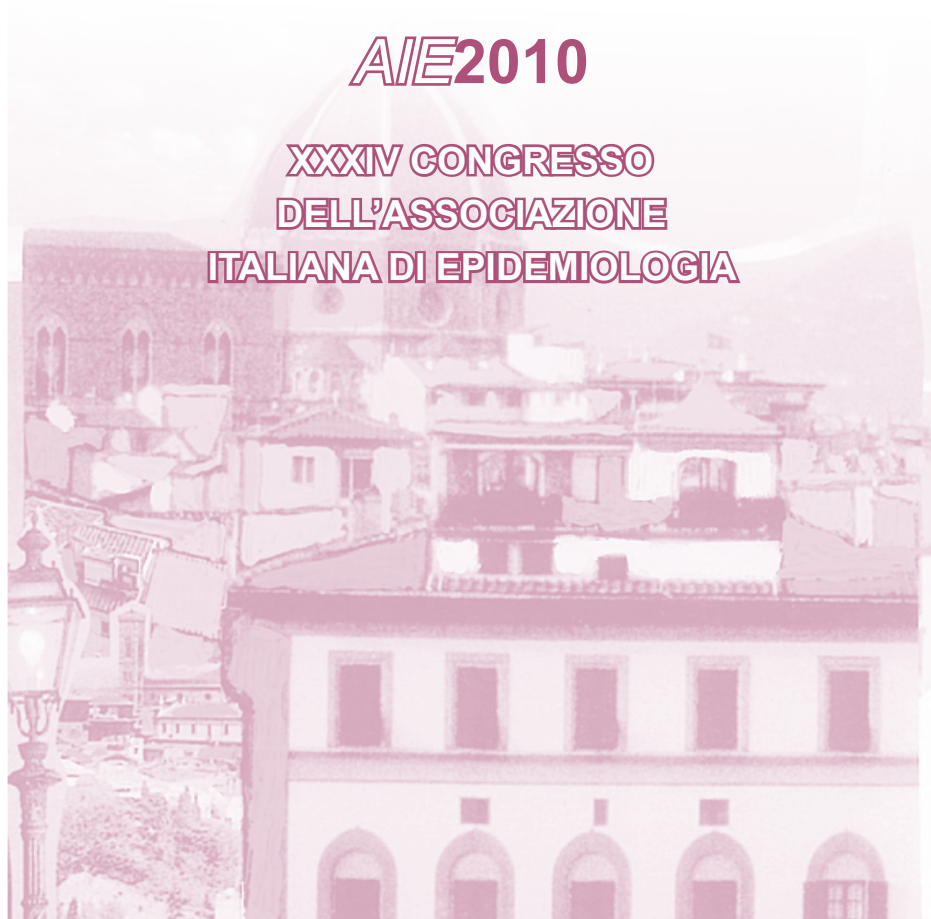

The poster session will take place during afternoon coffee-breaks on

**Sunday, November 7<sup>th</sup> from 16.00 to 17.00**

**and Monday, November 8<sup>th</sup> from 16.00 to 16.30**

Presenting author is recommended to be available at the poster during the above mentioned breaks.

We would like you to remind to observe the following instructions for your poster presentation:

- On the top of the board should be indicated: title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s), and affiliation (s)
- Poster should be printed with visible characters (font not smaller than size 36)
- Text should be divided into: objective, introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusions
- The text should be complete but concise. Try to emphasize concepts, highlighting the most important words and sentences. Avoid unnecessary tables, graphs, and details
- The presenter is recommended to remain with the poster during the above mentioned breaks to answer the audience questions
- If you deem it useful, you can prepare poster copies to distribute (A4 or letter format)
- Posters must be mounted and removed as above
- Posters will be displayed in a specific POSTER AREA and only for the indicated period of time
- The space available for each poster is **150 cm high and 90 cm wide VERTICAL ORIENTED** (horizontal oriented posters cannot be accepted)
- The secretariat will provide the necessary material to fix the poster
- The secretariat will indicate **only the number of the poster on the panel** (title and authors will have to be prepared by the author)
- We kindly remind you that it is strictly forbidden to fix your poster on a board different from the assigned one (for any need please contact any referee of the organizing secretariat on site)
- The **presenting author should be registered in the congress**
- The organizing secretariat is not responsible for those posters that are not removed at the end of the congress
